Studied at the Universities of Tübingen and Munich and Virginia Polytechnic Institute, USA; MA in Philosophy, Dr. phil (Philosophy) and Master of Economic (Diplom-Volkswirt), Munich University. Since 1997, Chair, Forum for Economic Ethics and Economic Culture, Deutsche Gesellschaft für Philosophie-German Philosophical Association. Since 2002 Chair, Working Group Compliance and Ethics in Financial Institutions in the German Business Ethics Network. Since 2000 Member, Executive Committee, International Society for Business, Economics, and Ethics (ISBEE). 1998-2003 Senator, The Foundation of Lower Saxony (Stiftung Niedersachsen). Author of numerous books, translated in various languages. - Central books on business ethics: The Ethics of Capitalism, several English editions, first 1983 (with Springer, Berlin, New York, Tokyo 1996), last English edition 2002, sixth German edition 1998; Principles of Ethical Economy, English paperback edition 2001 Kluwer Academic Publishers, Dordrecht, Boston, London. - Central Books in Systematic Philosophy and Philosophy of Religion: Society and State.
