Professor Francesco Scacciati

(University of Turin)

Professor **Francesco Scacciati** teaches Political Economy in the Faculty of Political Sciences at the University of Torino since 2001. He taught Economics in the Faculty of Law at the University of Torino from 1991 to 2000. He has been President of the IAREP (International Association for Research in Economic Psychology), from 2005 to 2007 and Representative for Piedmont for the national research (PRIN) on “The Economics of Happiness and Social Interaction” from 2005 to 2007. Professor Scacciati was President of the APESP (Association for the Promotion of Experimental Economics), from 2000 to 2005, Member of the University of Torino Review Board from 1996 to 1999 and Member of the governing board of the University of Torino from 1986 to 1991. He has been Guest Lecturer at the University of Massachusetts (Amherst), in October 2000, for a series of lectures on the subject, “Globalization, Labor-saving investments and Employment in Developed Countries” and Guest Lecturer at De Paul University of Chicago in 1981, for a series of lectures on the mechanism of governing wage indexing in Italy.

Francesco Scacciati was Head national representative for the research sponsored by the European Commission on the attitudes and expectations of the European Population concerning the European unification and the Unitary Monetary System 1997 and Head representative for Europe on matters related to the macroeconomic aspects of the above mentioned research.
